

**CONWAY POLICE COMMISSION
MINUTES OF MEETING
February 23, 2010**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Conway Police Commission was brought to order at 0830 hours on Tuesday, February 23, 2010. In attendance were Chief Edward K. Wagner, Lieutenant Joseph A. Faia, Lieutenant Christopher C. Perley, Chairman Theresa L. Kennett, Commissioner Robert F. Porter, Commissioner David D. Doherty and Recording Secretary Jill K. Dicey.

Payroll and disbursements were handed out and signed.

On a motion by Commissioner Porter, and seconded by Commissioner Doherty, it was unanimously voted to approve the minutes of February 9, 2010.

Chief Wagner and Chairman Kennett will meet after the meeting to review the current union contract.

Chief Wagner reminded all that the Town Meeting is next Wednesday, March 3, at 7:00 p.m. at Kennett High School.

Chief Wagner advised that the voting portion of town meeting will be on April 13, 2010.

Chief Wagner advised that Officer Ryan Wallace has received notice that his National Guard deployment has been cancelled. It is unclear at this time if another deployment will be scheduled. Should Officer Wallace be deployed, the Police Department will use the guidelines set up by the Town for military leave of absences. In short, he will be paid by the military, be covered by their health insurance and have a leave of absence status with the Town. Also, the NH Retirement system will credit up to three years of service for military service as long as the employee returns to work within one year of his separation.

Commissioner Doherty asked about ordering the new cruisers. Chief Wagner advised that he will not order them until the money is approved at the town meeting. A discussion ensued about a new police vehicle being made by Carbine Auto. It is said to have twice the life and is specifically built for police use so it comes with the extras that normally have to be purchased such as light bars. There has been no indication of a cost as of yet.

At 0845, on a motion by Commissioner Porter, and seconded by Commissioner Doherty, it was unanimously voted to adjourn the regularly scheduled commission meeting.
