

**CONWAY POLICE COMMISSION  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
February 9, 2010**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Conway Police Commission was brought to order at 0830 hours on Tuesday, February 9, 2010. In attendance were Chief Edward K. Wagner, Lieutenant Christopher C. Perley, Chairman Theresa L. Kennett, Commissioner Robert F. Porter, Commissioner David D. Doherty and Recording Secretary Jill K. Dicey.

Payroll and disbursements were handed out and signed.

On a motion by Commissioner Porter, and seconded by Commissioner Doherty, it was unanimously voted to approve the minutes of January 26, 2010.

Chief Wagner advised that he is returning \$46.06 the 2009 budget.

Chief Wagner advised the public hearing is tomorrow, February 10, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. at the high school cafeteria.

Chief Wagner advised he has received cruiser bids as requested for one 2010 Ford Crown Victoria and one 2010 Ford Expedition. The total bids for both vehicles were; MacDonald Motors \$49,500, Irwin Motors \$49,500, Grappone Ford \$49,900. Chief Wagner advised the new Expedition would be replacing the Ford Explorer. Chief Wagner recommended purchasing the vehicles from Macdonald Motors.

On a motion by Commissioner Doherty, and seconded by Commissioner Porter, it was unanimously voted to award MacDonald Motors the Cruiser bid.

Chief Wagner advised he attended the budget committee meeting last night and added the \$14,379 he needed to add because of the NH Retirement increases.

Commissioner Doherty inquired what the new final 2010 budget number is. Chief Wagner advised \$2,586,292.

At 0836, a motion was made by Commissioner Doherty, and seconded by Commissioner Porter to move into non-public session per RSA 91-A: 3, II (a). The Commission was polled and voted as follows: Porter, yes, Doherty, yes, Kennett, yes. With a unanimous vote, the meeting was moved into non-public session.

Commissioner Doherty inquired if Chairman Kennett will be running for another term as police commissioner. Chairman Kennett advised she would be.

Lieutenant Perley brought forward an idea from Officer William Strong to display flags in or on the cruisers showing support for Officer Wallace once he is deployed to Afghanistan in August. Everyone present was in agreement to display the flags.

Commissioner Doherty asked that Chief Wagner have information available about how compensation, retirement and benefits will work for Officer Wallace while deployed.

At 0903, on a motion by Commissioner Porter, and seconded by Commissioner Doherty, it was unanimously voted to adjourn the regularly scheduled commission meeting.
