

**CONWAY POLICE COMMISSION  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
September 7, 2010**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Conway Police Commission was brought to order at 0830 hours on Tuesday, September 7, 2010. In attendance were Chief Edward K. Wagner, Chairman David D. Doherty, Commissioner Theresa L. Kennett, and Recording Secretary Jill K. Dicey.

Payroll and disbursements were handed out and signed.

On a motion by Chairman Doherty, and seconded by Commissioner Kennett, it was unanimously voted to approve the minutes of August 24, 2010.

Chief Wagner advised the Commission that no new letters of interest have been received in response to the Commissioner vacancy. The Commission tentatively agreed to appoint Rodney King pending his interview.

At 0845, Rodney King joined the meeting. Mr. King related that he has 15-18 years experience working with budgets, that he has been involved with the hiring and firing at his place of business for 15-20 years, that he has lived in Conway for 35 years, was the president of the Kiwanis Club for 6 years while his son was in school and has a flexible schedule that will accommodate the Commission meetings. Mr. King also related his interest in running for the position when the elections are held. He has no conflicts and feels the Police Commission is the best fit for him to serve the Town of Conway.

On a motion by Commissioner Kennett and seconded by Chairman Doherty, Rodney King was appointed to fill the remainder of the open Police Commissioner term.

At 0906, Rodney King left the meeting to be sworn-in at the Town Office.

At 0906, a motion was made by Commissioner Kennett, and seconded by Chairman Doherty to move into non-public session per RSA 91-A: 3, II (a). The Commission was polled and voted as follows: Doherty, yes, Kennett, yes. With a unanimous vote, the meeting was moved into non-public session.

At 1010, the public session reconvened.

At 1010, on a motion by Commissioner Kennett, and seconded by Commissioner King, it was unanimously voted to adjourn the regularly scheduled commission meeting.
